1,848

CLIENTS SERVED

We served over 1,800 Hoosiers in 2022 through direct services. In addition to those that received direct navigation, we also served over 2,400 clients and caregivers through our virtual programs and services.



104,447

MEALS

We provided over 104,000 individual meals to cancer patients in the form of nutritional supplements. Most clients are prescribed two to three meal supplements per day, which can be very impactful on a budget. Little Red Door is proud to continue to support the nutritional goals of our clients.



30,422

TRIPS TO TREATMENT

We provided over 30,000 trips to life-saving cancer treatments, at no cost to our clients. A cancer patient's ability to fully comply with and complete their physician's prescribed treatment program is one of the largest contributors to positive outcomes for a cancer diagnosis.



20,700

NAVIGATION CALLS

Our Client Services Representatives answered over 20,000 phone calls in 2022. Through these conversations we identified barriers to healthcare and connected clients with resources to help them make the most of life and least of cancer.

CARE PACKAGES

We provided more than 1,100 care packages to newly diagnosed cancer patients in Indiana in 2022. These care packages provide hope and comfort along the cancer treatment journey and include items like lotion, a journal, hand sanitizer, and a handmade no-sew blanket.

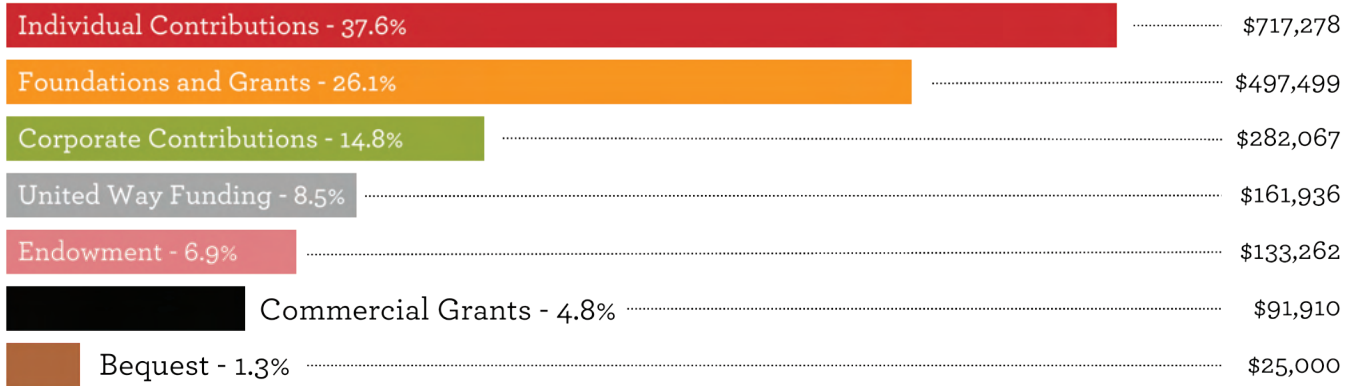
SURVIVORSHIP PROGRAMMING

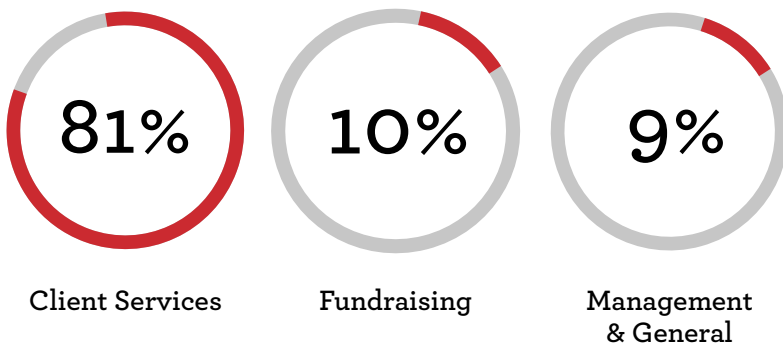

CLIENT NAVIGATION



Navigation is the backbone of the work that takes place each day at Little Red Door.

Little Red Door Client Services Representatives and Care Managers have always provided vital support to Indiana cancer patients and caregivers. In 2022, Client Services Representatives continued to work with Hoosiers on the cancer continuum to ensure they have access to quality care and support.

Fundamentally, Little Red Door's Client Services Representatives work towards improving access to healthcare for the medically underserved cancer patients and survivors in Indiana. Every single call that comes in from our clients or their caregivers is answered. Client Services Representatives currently can communicate with clients in 17 different languages using the Language Line.

Client Services Representatives and Care Managers connect with our clients on a one-on-one basis to identify what needs and services Little Red Door can provide and how Little Red Door can support them on their cancer journey.

In 2022, all of Little Red Door's programming returned to in-person attendance. The Client Services team was excited to have clients back in the building participating in Little Red Door's survivorship program, Door to Wellness, as well as getting other services like wig fittings and therapeutic oncology massage.

Looking forward to 2023, the Client Services team is excited to bring new and updated programming to clients while continuing to provide great care. Client Services Representatives and Care Managers love connecting with our clients and providing support through their cancer journey.

OUR SURVIVORSHIP PROGRAM



Cancer survivors face unique challenges. The side effects of cancer treatment can result in barriers to wellbeing such as pain, reduced strength and flexibility, digestive system issues, lymphedema, fatigue, social isolation, and suppressed immune system. Our Door to Wellness programming offers our clients a space and opportunity to join a community of people facing the same journey and similar challenges. In 2022, we were finally able to welcome clients back for in-person programming.

Every bit of Door to Wellness programming is designed with the needs and desires of cancer survivors in mind. Door to Wellness programs include cooking demonstrations, yoga classes, fitness courses, crafting, therapeutic oncology massage, and more! Door to Wellness is available to all Little Red Door clients and their caregivers regardless of where they are at on the cancer continuum.

At Little Red Door, our mission is to ease the burden that cancer creates for everyone affected. We provide our pediatric clients with the same care as our adult clients: transportation assistance to and from treatment, nutritional supplements, meals, and Door to Wellness programming, with the addition of multiple camp experiences throughout the year available to any pediatric oncology patient in any of Indiana's 92 counties.



At Little Red Door, we strive to create an environment where kids with cancer can focus on just being a kid. Our goal is to provide care and support to the entire family. This year, we offered activities across Indiana for families to come together to hangout and build community. From picnics to family camp weekends, families were able to connect with each other and spend time with others who understand what their unique journey is like. We look forward to continue these family events in 2023 and beyond!

Throughout the year, we hosted monthly activities for our youth clients, both in-person and virtually. One of these events, Kids in the Kitchen, gives kids a chance to be the chef of their very own dish! Other activities included crafting, science experiences, rock painting, pottery, and more.

Eat Well, Live Well is a cooking video series where Little Red Door's Director and CEO, Fred Duncan, invites local Celebrity Chefs to cook tasty, healthy, easily accessible, and affordable meals that anyone can make at home to help reduce their risk for cancer and improve their outlook as they go through a cancer treatment journey. In 2022, we showcased more than seventeen recipes through the Eat Well, Live Well series.

Celebrity Chefs at Little Red Door can be anybody who loves to cook and who is excited about creating healthy meals that can reduce cancer risk or recurrence. Fred hosted a variety of chefs this year from Karen Holmes, owner of 10th Street Diner, to Janet Holcomb, First Lady of Indiana. Many Little Red Door staff members and Board of Directors members came along as Celebrity Chefs, too!

Meet Dr. Erika Rager! Dr. Rager serves on Little Red Door's Board of Directors and is a breast and melanoma surgeon at Franciscan Health. She also provides leadership for our client services and programs on our Board's program committee and is a former Board Chair. Try Dr. Rager's Sweet Potato and Spinach Quesadillas!



Ingredients

- 2 medium sweet potatoes (~1 pound)
- 1/4 teaspoon kosher salt and ground black pepper
- 1 cup red-wine vinegar
- 8 6-inch flour tortillas
- 1/2 cup sugar
- 5 cups baby spinach
- 4 black peppercorns
- 1 cup shredded cheese
- 1 large red onion, sliced
- 4 teaspoons olive oil

Step-by-Step

1. Using a fork, poke holes into sweet potatoes and microwave on high until tender for about 15 minutes
2. Meanwhile, combine red-wine vinegar, sugar, and peppercorns in a medium saucepan. Bring to a boil, stirring occasionally to dissolve the sugar. Place onion slices in a heat-proof bowl, pour the hot vinegar mixture over them, and stir. Let sit at least 10 minutes, and then drain onion slices and transfer to a separate container. Let onions marinate longer for a stronger pickled flavor.
3. Split cooked potatoes with a knife and allow them to cool. Remove skins and transfer to a bowl. Mash the potatoes and add salt and pepper. Spread the mashed potato onto a tortilla. Top with one cup of spinach and a quarter cup of cheese, and another tortilla.
4. Add oil to a large nonstick skillet and heat on medium-high heat. Transfer one quesadilla at a time and cook until the cheese is melted and the tortilla is crispy. Cut quesadillas into quarters and top with pickled onions.
5. Enjoy!

Transportation program provided over 30,000 rides to cancer treatment



30,422

In 2022, we provided over 30,000 rides for cancer patients to and from cancer treatment.



Transportation to cancer treatment is one of the most significant barriers for cancer patients.

Imagine hearing the words “you have cancer.” For everyone, it will stop you in your tracks. Now, imagine being unsure how you will get to and from treatment, or if you can even get to treatment at all. These are fears that Little Red Door clients face each day. Upon diagnosis, many Little Red Door clients have told us they weren't going to be able to make it to their treatment appointments. On average, a cancer patient needs 14 round-trip rides during their treatment. At \$27.50 a trip, clients will pay more than \$385 for transportation alone.

Little Red Door provides transportation assistance to clients while they are in active treatment. Our Client Services Representatives work with our clients to determine what is the best way to get them to treatment, whether that's through gas cards, utilizing Uber or Lyft, or through Z-trip.

Thanks to support from generous donors, Little Red Door fills the gap for cancer patients in need of transportation. In 2022, we provided more than 30,000 trips to treatment for clients that have nowhere to turn. Not only does this provide economic relief for our clients, minimizing the barrier to access treatment has significant positive impact, reducing the risk of recurrence and mortality.
